CYNTHIA OMORI

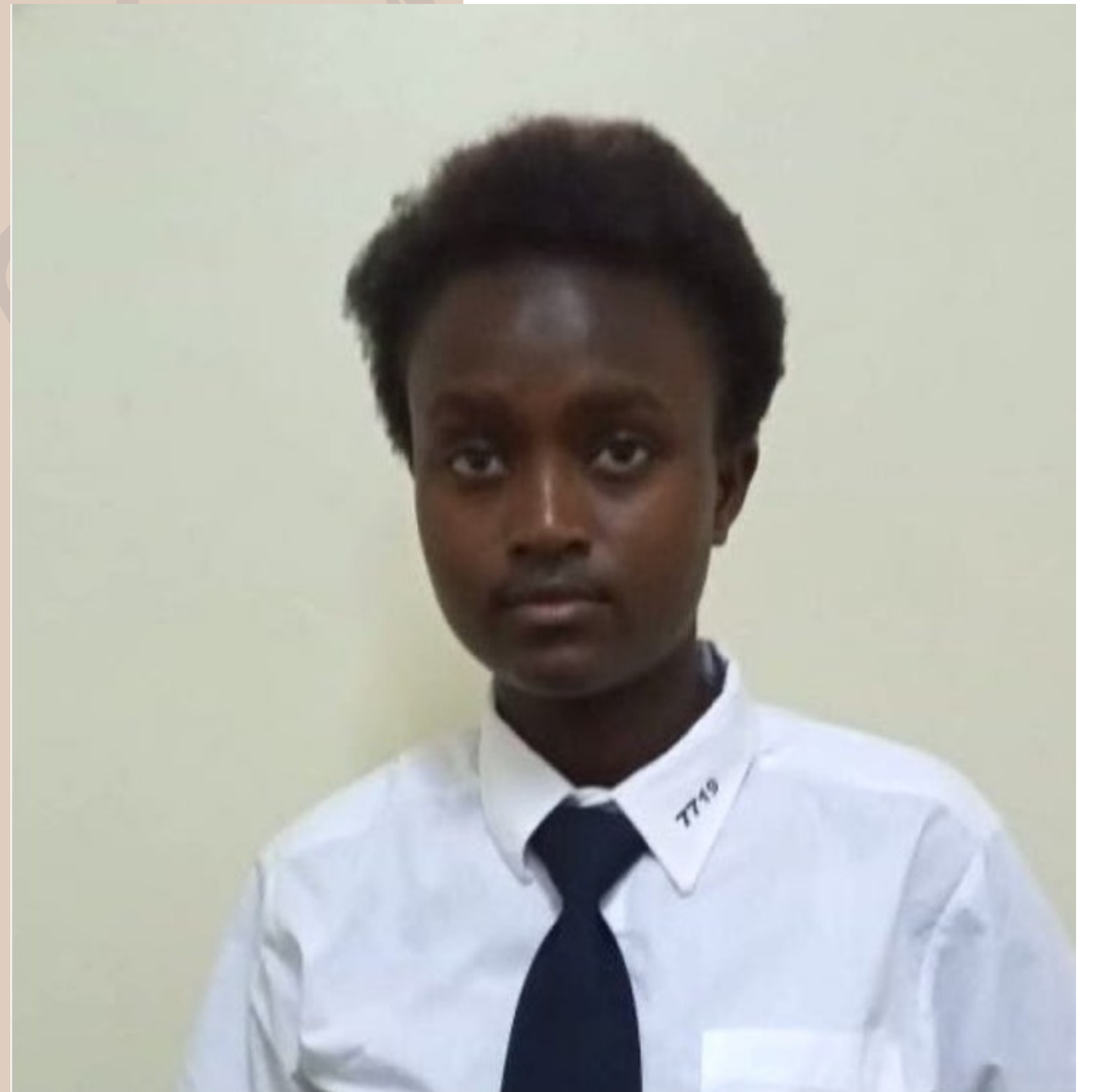

SHARON WANGECHI

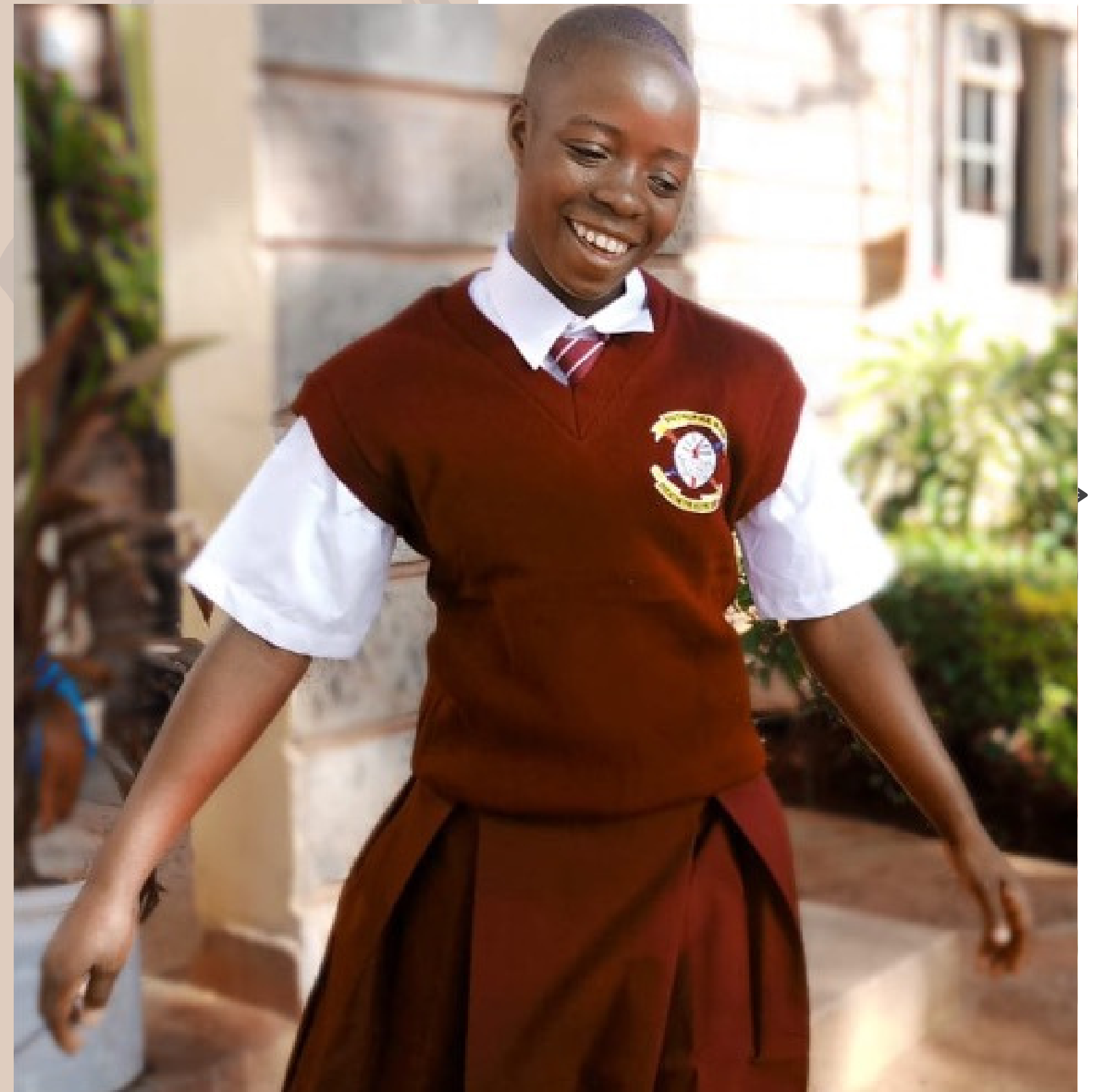
